Check-In:

- Please check in 30 minutes before your first game. Bring a roster and certificate of insurance to your first game. Birth Certificates must be available throughout the tournament. Rosters and certificates of insurance will not be returned.

Game Rules Pool Play:

- Coin Flip will determine which team has choice of home or away.
- Continuous batting order and free substitution must be used.
- A courtesy runner may be used for the catcher and pitcher at any time. The runner must be the last player in the game to have made an out. *(unless the last out is the pitcher or catcher).*
- There are no run limits per inning.
- No new inning will start after 1 hour and 15 minutes, finish the inning. If the home team is leading at the end of the half inning, the game is considered complete and the home team will not bat. Games can end in a tie.
- Mercy Rule: are 12 runs after 3 innings, 10 after 4 innings and 8 after 5innings.
- NO PROTESTS - the ruling of the umpire is final.
- A new inning is considered to have started immediately following the final out of the previousinning.

Game Rules Bracket Play:

- Tie-breaker: Total Record; Runs allowed; Runs Differential - Coin flip.
- To begin bracket play, the better seeded team will be the home team. Subsequent winners of those games will assume the seed of the higher rated team.
- Coaches' Choice as to Continuous Batting Order/ free subs OR use of limited Batting Order w/subs and use of DP/Flex.
- No new inning will start after 1 hour and 15 minutes, finish the inning. Games ending in a tie will play international tie breaker rules.
- Mercy Rule: are 12 runs after 3 innings, 10 after 4 innings and 8 after 5innings.
- NO PROTESTS - the ruling of the umpire is final.
- The Championship game does not have a time limit.
- Two umpires per bracket play game.

Tournament Rules:

- USSSA Rules apply.
- Game time is Forfeit time. Allowances will be made for teams travelling from another park.
- Please no "warm up" music prior to 8:30 am games at Borse Park. We are located in a residential area.
- In good sportsmanship, we ask there be NO cheering against opponents.
- No pre-recorded, personalized walk-up music/introductions from electronic devices/speakers.
- Offensive behavior by coaches, players or spectators could lead to their ejections. If this happens the responsible party or parties will be required to leave the fields of play as well as the Park District property. Tournament Director will review the case and determine if the offender(s) will be allowed back on the Park District property for the remainder of the tournament. Your team may forfeit games due to bad behavior. Please act responsibly at all times and inform the spectators of the potential for ejection and forfeiture for offensive behavior. Any spectator who enters the field of play will cause an immediate forfeiture of the game and tournament for their team.
- If there is a dispute over dugouts, a coin toss shall decide. Any team playing back to back games on the same field has dugout priority.
- Only managers may consult with umpires. Managers shall declare themselves prior to the start of the game to the umpire.
- Trophies will be awarded for the Champion and 2nd place teams and individual players.
- This is not a qualifier or sanctioned tournament.
- Games may start up to 10 minutes early.
